OneGoal + Early College



The Early College Initiative presents a unique opportunity to close opportunity gaps and make education equity a reality in Massachusetts. The potential for impact and scale are exciting, but successfully implementing an Early College program comes with challenges. The stakes are high for students to have an experience that supports their transcript and their confidence in going to college. And schools and districts must invest significant financial and people capacity to develop partnerships, build out the local program, and ensure student success.

OneGoal is proud to offer solutions that work in alignment with Early College and address these challenges. In total, OneGoal has advised over **300 students** through our OneGoal+Early College Classroom Model and trained 35 programs that represent nearly **2,000 Early College students** through our Advancing Early College and Leadership Network.

Keys to Success >

Based on our extensive experience across the state, working alongside partners and Early College practitioners, we know what it takes to have a successful Early College program:

- + Partners need resources and support to create the conditions for student success. This work requires transformative work for secondary and postsecondary partners and high levels of collaboration and engagement from leaders across sectors.
- + Students need more than just academic support to find success in Early College. They need:
 - A sense of community and connection to take risks and navigate challenges.
 - Rigorous 1:1 advising that helps them plan for and navigate the transition to postsecondary aligned to their early college experience
 - Equitable access and support, inclusive of all identity markers

We bring these learnings, along with our statewide relationships, when we partner with schools and districts to ensure that Early College delivers on its promise to close opportunity gaps and support students across the state!



Our three-year model starts as a class in junior and senior year of high school; students participate in OneGoal alongside their Early College course. We then bridge the transition to a student's chosen postsecondary pathway by providing continued, individualized support for a full year after high school graduation. This combination of OneGoal and Early College enhances a student's overall experience and likelihood of success in college + career.
