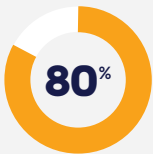

A postsecondary education - college, trade school, and other pathways - unlocks opportunities for students and entire communities. Yet for millions of underserved students, it remains out of reach. In Illinois, only 44% of high school graduates from low income communities enroll in a higher ed institution the fall after high school*. This is not for lack of ambition or talent, but for lack of support.

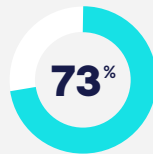
