Why We Are Here ↘

A postsecondary education – college, trade school, and other pathways – unlocks opportunities for students and entire communities. Yet for millions of underserved students, it remains out of reach. New York City is the largest school district in the country, serving 1.1 million students, but only 24% of Black and 24% of Latinx 9th graders in our city attain an associates or bachelor's degree within six years of high school graduation, compared to 45% of their white peers*. This is not for lack of ambition or talent, but for lack of support.
